Do you have muscle or joint problems?

The free GetUBetter app has been designed in collaboration with local health professions and is now available for people across north cumbia to download.

The app will offer tips, advice and exercises tailored to you and your stage of recover.

The symptom checker will allow the app to give you specific advice based on your main issues. It covers back neck, shoulder, elbow, hi, leg, knee and ankle pain as well as tendinopathy.

It will give you the tools to self-care your condition at home and even better, around your own schedule. It will also redirect you to the appropriate service where more specialist treatment is required.
